

Counting Coins in your Happy Dragon Moneybox



When your Happy Dragon Moneybox is full, or whenever you want to count your money and deposit it into your account, you can use this worksheet. Here's what to do:



1. Tip out all your coins on to the floor (or on the table if Mum or Dad says it is OK).
2. Put the coins in piles. When you're finished you'll have up to 6 piles - one for each type of coin.
3. Count the number of coins you have in each pile. You can use the table below to figure out how much money you have saved of each type of coin. E.g. If you have 6 twenty cent coins, this makes \$1.20. Alternatively, an interactive version of this worksheet is available at www.stgeorge.com.au/happydragonclub that will auto-calculate the value of the number of coins you nominate

4. You can use the worksheet over the page to write the number of each type of coin you have.
5. Get Mum's or Dad's help to add up the amounts, and calculate the total amount of your savings.
6. Take your savings to the Bank and deposit it into your St.George account.
